### Fields of Study

The degree programs are designed to meet the challenges of the 21st century. The academic programs teach the skills and attitudes necessary to understand and successfully cope with the rapidly changing international world.

The four-year BSc program lays down a strong foundation for a successful future in higher studies or

the professional world. The program can be completed in less than four years by taking summer semesters. Broad-based core courses in math, languages, natural sciences and the social sciences in the first year prepare the student for more advanced courses leading to specialization in any of the following:

- Bachelor of Science in Computer Science
- Bachelor of Science in Business Administration
  - Finance
  - Management
  - Marketing
  - Information Systems

Upon completing graduation requirements, the student will receive an accredited American Degree identical to the degree that students receive in the U.S.

### Computer Science

The fields of information and communication technologies have seen an explosive growth in the last few years. In a knowledge driven economy, it is imperative to stay abreast with the latest developments in Computer Science.

The BSc program offers a wide array of coursework that is consolidated with hands on programming experience. The program combines the analysis of computing systems with the science of creating computer software. The program emphasizes breadth of knowledge and the development of written and oral communication skills, the trademarks of a liberal arts education, combined with professional competence in computer science. The curriculum’s mathematics component ensures that students have the formal tools to remain current as technologies and systems change, rather than be limited by a narrow focus on programming alone. It also combines a solid core of computer science courses with the ability to gain substantial depth in another area through required technical electives.

### Finance

Finance is a vital business operation and requires knowledge and understanding of all functional areas of business. The program offers students an integrative approach to the fields of financial markets and careers in corporate finance, banking, real estate, and insurance. Students will develop the analytical tools and theoretical framework necessary to analyze and understand the financial sector. Furthermore, this concentration provides the essential tools for understanding investments, financial institutions, financial analysis and management in the context of international financial environment.

### Management

The management concentration is designed to offer undergraduates an opportunity to obtain proficiency in management skills and decision making that would enable them to carry out responsibilities in both the public and private sectors. Students will gain an understanding of the importance of management to society and how management can be a force for positive change in a rapidly changing and competitive business environment.

### Marketing

Marketing is a very diverse field with career opportunities in sales, advertising, retailing, sales promotion, brand management and marketing research. Marketers are involved in demand analysis, consumer research, product development, promotional activities, distribution and pricing.

The marketing courses focus on the practical application of marketing concepts and procedures for developing promotions, pricing of products, channels of distribution, and sales management strategies.

### Information Systems

The information systems (IS) program is designed to prepare students for careers in information systems. Information is a resource that must be researched, designed, planned, managed, and controlled in the same way as other more traditional types of resources. There is a high demand for individuals with a combined knowledge of business and computer applications. The information systems program is designed to meet this demand by providing students with the educational background to develop information systems. The information systems program differs from a computer science program in that the information systems student is taught to focus on solutions to practical business problems. The information systems degree prepares a student to appreciate the complexity of system design, system maintenance, and user satisfaction by providing an interface between hardware and software solutions for business problems.

### Admission Requirements

- Students seeking admission must have completed the:
- a. U.A.E. General Secondary School Certificate or its equivalent, or the
  - b. IGCSE, GCSE, GCE ( O Level): at least 5 subjects graded C or better
  - c. Graduation from a high school after completing not less than 12 years of education, and
  - d. One of the following if your native language is not English:

- Test of English as a Foreign Language [TOEFL] score. Minimum acceptable score is 500 paper-based /173 computer-based.
- American College Testing Program (ACT) score. Minimum acceptable composite score is 18 with at least an 18 on the verbal portion.
- Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT-1) score. Minimum acceptable composite score on the SAT is 870 with at least 430 score on the verbal portion.
- IELTS score (English Language Proficiency Test). Minimum acceptable score is 5.5.

### Placement Test

To complete the requirements for admission, an applicant must sit for entrance examinations in both English and Mathematics. The purpose of this test is to place a student in the appropriate course. The student may be placed in either a pre-degree or degree course depending on his/her ability to comprehend and express in the English language.

- Students with (SAT-1) score of at least 450 on the math portion are exempted from Math placement test.
- Students with TOEFL score of 500 (computer based 173) or equivalent are exempted from English placement test.

### Intensive English Program

For students who fail to obtain the minimum passing grade on the English and/or Mathematics Placement Test, a Foundation Program that gives intensive coaching in English and/or Mathematics is provided.

### Campus and Facilities

The Sharjah campus is equipped with state-of-the-art technology with 16 lecture rooms, a well-stocked library of 14,000 volumes, Electronics, Physics, Chemistry, Digital Electronics laboratories and four computer laboratories. Each computer lab is linked to the Internet. Troy University provides an intensive on-line library database, consisting of thousands of journals, available 24 hours per day.

Incorporating state-of-the-art technologies, the campus has a dormitory for 300 students, a cafeteria and outdoor sports facilities such as volleyball and basketball courts.

- The student must complete a minimum of 30 Troy credits in residence at Sharjah Campus or another Troy campus. The 30 credits may be taken from the approved Troy courses in the Business, Business Core, Computer Science, and/or other subject areas. At least 50 percent of the degree program must be 3000 or 4000 level credit.
- The tuition fees for the final 30 credits will be at the rate of AED 375 per credit plus AED 3000/- base tuition fees in addition to AED 225 per credit to be paid for the Troy University to facilitate registering the student to meet the residency requirements.

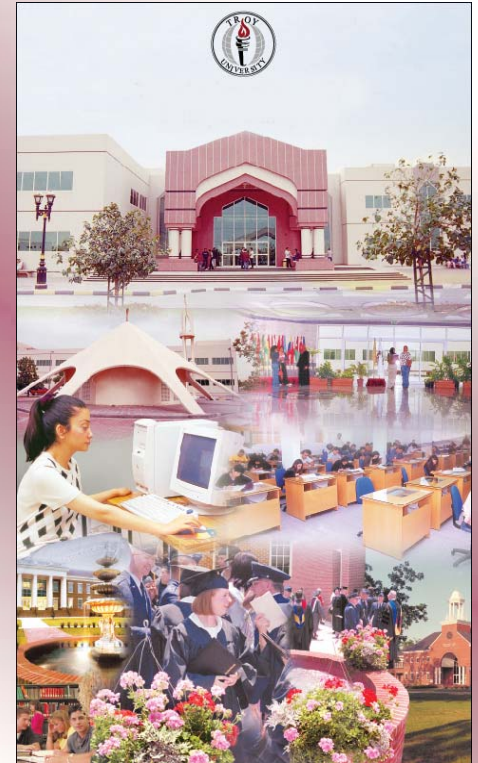
